During the implementation of the project, a total of 81 participants were involved through training courses and workshops.

As part of the cooperation, 11 new courses were developed, and 19 existing ones were updated.

The Lao universities purchased the necessary teaching equipment and two people from Souphanouvoung University had training directly at Freiburg university within an exchange activity.
